

## Hebrews 11

“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.”  
(Hebrews 11:1 AV)

### Purpose:

We will read Hebrews 11:1-12:1 and create a book-like craft in order to remember the examples of faith listed in this passage.

### Materials needed:

8 ½” X 14” blank paper (enough for each student to have one piece)  
pencils, colored pencils, markers, and/or crayons  
printed labels (optional)  
scissors

(We took two class periods to complete this project and sang Hebrews 11:1 while we worked. A recording of the song is on our website under Kids’ Songs)

### To create the book layout:

Using an 8½” by 14” sheet of paper, fold in half length-wise to create a long, thin book.



Fold each end in 1/3 of the way so that the length of the paper is in thirds.



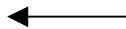
Fold in half two more times—making firm creases each time.



Unfold so that only your original fold remains (leaving a long, thin book with 11 creases).

With the book facing you, draw a line on each of the creases both on the front of the booklet and the inside.

Write the word “Faith” in each of the 12 sections on the front cover.



At this point, begin reading the text and stop to write or draw in each section of the inside of the book as follows:

Section 1: 11:1 (write the verse or put a label with the verse printed on it in the first section on the inside of the booklet)

Section 2: 11:3 (draw worlds, sun, moon, etc. in the 2<sup>nd</sup> section)

Section 3: 11:4 (draw smiling Abel with lamb and frowning Cain with produce in the 3<sup>rd</sup> section)

Section 4: 11:5 (draw Enoch walking and “poof” cloud)

Section 5: 11:7 (draw Noah and the ark)

Section 6: 11:8-19 (draw Abraham leaving, tents, and Abraham and Isaac going up a mountain to sacrifice)

Section 7: 11:20-21 (draw Isaac blessing Jacob and Esau and Jacob blessing Joseph’s sons)

Section 8: 11:22 (draw Josephs bones)

Section 9: 11:23-29 (draw Moses in a basket, the blood on the door, and God’s people crossing the Red Sea)

Section 10: 11:30 (draw the walls of Jericho falling)

Section 11: 11:31 (draw smiling Rahab)

Section 12: 11:32-12:1 (let each student draw his/her choice in this last section)

The final step is to cut along the lines on the FRONT COVER OF THE BOOKLET ONLY, so that each section can be revealed one-at-a-time.



Use the book to review the examples in Hebrews 11.
